Education: to help parents gain a better understanding of how children develop language and of the conversational strategies that promote their child's language development.

Application: to provide opportunities for parents to practice creating language learning opportunities during interaction and conversations with their child.

Support: to give parents opportunities to share ideas, issues, and concerns with other parents who are in similar situations.
