

CTG CATERPILLARS FEEDING CAMP

About CTG Caterpillars

CTG Caterpillars is a language rich feeding camp for children ages 4-6 years who are picky eaters and problem feeders. It addresses the unique feeding needs of each child in a fun and supportive setting that can be utilized at home. New foods and non-preferred foods are introduced following a modified Sequential Oral Sensory (SOS) feeding protocol in a small group to allow for opportunities to interact with and observe their peers during food-based tasks.

Trained speech-language pathologists in the SOS program and other feeding-based therapy techniques strive to make interactions with food a pleasant experience and provide strategies to use at home.

Is CTG Caterpillars Camp right for my child?

Caterpillars Camp may be right for your child if he or she:

- Is potty-trained
- Can follow two-step directions
- Attends to a task for 10-15 minutes
- Primarily receives nutrients orally (if transitioning from a G-tube, must tolerate food in the mouth)

Schedule

Camp will be 2 weeks, each month, with carryover into the next month.
